Sexual Assault Referral Centre (SARC)

Grange Park is a centre providing services to men, women and children living in the Staffordshire area, who have been raped or sexually assaulted.

All of our services are free and confidential.



Our services include:

Crisis Worker support - A Crisis Worker will support you during your time at the SARC

Forensic Medical Examination – An examination to collect evidence when you have been raped or sexually assaulted. We also make sure that your emotional health and well-being is discussed to ensure you are safe and well.

Access to Emergency Contraception – We can provide a range of emergency contraception to prevent unplanned pregnancy.

Testing for Sexually Transmitted Infections – An aftercare form will be completed with you to try and address any risk of sexually transmitted infection. Treatment will be provided to you if needed.

Referrals for support with counselling – With your agreement, we can refer you for ongoing care and support to help you in your recovery.



You can refer yourself to Grange Park (as long you're 16 or over) or another person can refer on your behalf.
