Staffordshire Survive offers a free, non-judgmental and confidential service for adults, children over the age of 4, and close family members/significant others who have been affected by sexual assault or abuse at any point during their lives across Staffordshire and Stoke on Trent.

As part of Survive you will provide a high quality, victim/survivor-focused and trauma informed support service to those who have been subjected to sexual assault and abuse, and/or sexual coercion in Staffordshire and Stoke on Trent.

You will support and work closely with Team Leaders, Independent Sexual Violence Advisors (ISVAs), Children's Independent Sexual Violence Advisors (ChISVAs) and the Family Support Practitioner to help victims cope and recover from their experiences.

You will work closely with partner agencies including the Police, Victim Gateway, Sexual Assault Referral Centre (SARC), Crown Prosecution Service (CPS), Witness Care, Sexual Health and NHS services as well as voluntary sector organisations, to ensure service users access the most appropriate forms of support.

You will have experience and understanding of the traumatic effects and impacts of sexual violence, sexual abuse and assault, sexual exploitation and sexual coercion, and understanding of criminal justice processes.

**A full driving licence and access to a vehicle are essential requirements of the post.**
